# From the President's Disc

The 1995 season of events is under way and the activity is heavy around the world. The 1995 World Ultimate Club Championships is prepared and ready to engage nearly 1,000 disc athletes for a ultimate fest of huge proportions. Wham-O manufacturing was bought from Kransco by Mattel, the World's Biggest Disc Golf Event saw nearly 15,000 participate in a round of disc golf simply for fun and entertainment.

I started as president in the fall of 1994 in the wake of a very productive stretch by our previous president Robert Rauch. Nob' agenda to make a more active valuable World Flying Disc Federation has given us a strong administrative guide to future activities. Our goals and objectives are now more clearly defined. Our job now is to implement the procedures set forth by the previous administration and continue to move forward towards the promotion of; educational activities, international amateur competition, and ourselves as the umbrella for all flying disc sports. From these strengths we should be able to gain significantly in the general world wide awareness of disc sports. Eventually translating into commercial

support for the sport.

- 1. The status of the IWGA proposal that was sent out in late February has returned with an unfavorable vote from the Secretary-General Co Koren. Moro and I will work on an explanation to appeal the decision since it seems we did not inform them well enough. We also hope to get them a more complete, professional video specifically on the sport of ultimate.
- 2. Charlie, I'm sure has been working very hard to finalize all the details for this years World Ultimate Club Championships. The final seeding have been posted and nearly 1,000 players are signed up for the event. We all want to wish Charlie the best of luck with the major task ahead of him.
- 3. The future of WFDF and UPA rules may finally be coming to common ground. We have requested that the format for the UPA rules be aligned with that of the current WFDF rule book. It seems since the UPA is reviewing their whole set of rules, it would be a good time to become united in this area. I would suspect that our ultimate committee will work closely in adopting the rules universally for WFDF. The primary hope of WFDF is that the rules are in our format and numbering system. Troy Fever from the UPA has been in contact with us regarding the alignment of the two sets of rules.

4. NO INDIVIDUAL CHAMPI-ONSHIPS FOR WFDF - Unfortunately we have missed a year of overall tournament play sanctioned by the WFDF. This area of competition is has been the hardest to promote of late. Mattel has done a great job with the overall format for State competitions. This year they anticipate all 50 States participating in some sort of overall competition. Internationally the Swe-Disc Open will be the largest overall event this season. It is appropriate to continue conversation on overall competition to see what steps we can take to increase the awareness and schedule future event further in advance. Hopefully we can prevent the scramble that occurred this Fall trying to find a site to host the

5. I thought Jonas Löf had many interesting ideas on disc golf. I am surprised that more have not commented on the lengthy report that came out with the last newsletter. I for one appreciate this information and feel it can be extremely valuable in deciding who is responsible for what. The last thing any of us want is to duplicate tasks. Although I do not feel we need another organization (IDGA). The duties for WFDF should cover many of the educational aspects of the sport. Each individual country may want to have a national disc golf association similar to that of the PDGA and what it means to the United States. WFDF should be responsible for accumulating the information from the different countries and applying the information to produce rule changes and adjustments in the organization of the sport.

In closing, I hope that some of these topics can be discussed at the congress in England. Since Johan will be stepping down as the producer of the newsletter we will all need to step up our communication efforts in order to keep the information to our members. We hope to produce a newsletter through an existing publication (Disc Golf World). Our hopes is that more people will see and hear about the WFDF and our information will be timely. At the congress we should work towards appointing a new Secretary for WFDF. Many, many thanks to Johan for being the glue that has held

us all together from the very beginning.

Moro and I will be attending the General Association for International Sport Federation Congress in Seoul Korea, October 23-27 1995. We hope to have made our appeal to IWGA for membership into the International World Games Association and to become full members of GAISF (we are now provisional members). Our hopes is that this will help many of our member countries get support for their organizations and the international view of disc sports will continue to be legitimized as a true sport.

Participating delegates will be listed and a voting list will be drawn up. Each association is allowed to send 5 representatives to the Congress but only one of those has the right to vote. The association must have payed the fee to WFDF to recieve a vote. The following associations has payed their fees and recieve one vote: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Holland, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, UK, UPA and USDS. The following owe fees and do not recieve a vote if they do not pay what they owe, together with the late fee of CHF 25, before the Congress: Australia (94+95) Canada (93+94+95), Czech republic (95), FPA (95), GPA (91+92+93+94+95), Italy (95), Japan (95), Mexico (95), New Zealand (95), Norway (95), PDGA (92+93+94+95).
