I am responsible for the smooth (and sometimes not-so-smooth) running of all aspects of UK Ultimate. Inevitably this means doing a very wide range of tasks from answering the phone, to providing technical support to players renewing their membership, through to working with our Board on our organisation's priorities, to running some of the many Ultimate events that occur in the UK every year. I also put in significant time with both WFDF and European ultimate committees.

Some highlights from this period:

- Membership more than doubled
- Income more than tripled
- Developed and delivered an "Introductory Ultimate coaching workshop" for teachers and sports coaches. We have now delivered to 1000+ participants (mostly school teachers)
- UK Ultimate Association became UK Ultimate Ltd under a "Company Limited by Guarantee" structure
- UKU hosted European Club Championships 2009
